## 3 Description


The GD30LD2401 is a high voltage, low power consumption and high performance LDO. The family uses an advanced CMOS process and a P-MOSFET pass device to achieve fast start-up, with high output voltage accuracy. The GD30LD2401 is stable with a 1.0- $\mu F$  to  $10\mu F$  ceramic output capacitor, and uses a precision voltage reference and feedback loop to achieve a worst-case accuracy of 2% over all load, line, process, and temperature variations.




Figure 1. Normal Version Without Enable




Figure 2. Shutdown Version With Enable






Figure 4. Quiescent Current vs. Temperature

#### 6.1 Block Diagram




Figure 5. GD30LD2401 Functional Block Diagram

#### 6.2 Operation

The external input and output capacitors of GD30LD2401 series must be properly selected for stability and performance. Use a 1µF or larger input capacitor and place it close to the device IN and GND pins. The GD30LD2401 series is designed specifically to work with low ESR ceramic output capacitor in space-saving and performance consideration. Place the output capacitor close to the device OUT and GND pins. Increasing capacitance and decreasing ESR can improve the circuit's PSRR and line transient response.

#### 6.2.1 Dropout Voltage

The GD30LD2401 series use a PMOS pass transistor to achieve low dropout. When ( VIN - VOUT ) is less than the dropout voltage ( $V_{DO}$ ), the PMOS pass device is in the linear region of operation and the input-to-output resistance is the  $R_{DS(ON)}$  of the PMOS pass element.  $V_{DO}$  scales approximately with the output current because the PMOS device behaves as a resistor in dropout condition.

#### 6.2.2 Short Circuit Protection

When output current at the OUT pin is higher than current limit threshold or the OUT pin is short-circuit to GND, the short-circuit protection will be triggered and clamp the output current to approximately 200 mA to prevent over-current and to protect the regulator from damage due to overheating.

#### 6.2.3 Thermal Shutdown



The over temperature protection function of GD30LD2401 series will turn off the P-MOSFET when the junction temperature exceeds 155°C (typical). Once the junction temperature cools down by approximately 20°C, the regulator will automatically resume operation.

#### 6.3 Device Mode Description

#### 6.3.1 Device Enable

The GD30LD2401 series has an EN pin to turn on or turn off the regulator, When the EN pin is in logic high, the regulator will be turned on. When the EN pin is in logic low, the shutdown current is almost 0.1µA typical. Furthermore, the EN pin prohibit floating and may be directly tied to IN to keep the part on.



## 7 Application Information

The GD30LD2401 is high voltage, low power consumption and low dropout LDO. Its output voltage is fixed, providing two versions with or without enable.




Figure 6. With Enable Mode Reference Design




Figure 7. Without Enable Mode Reference Design

#### 7.2 Detailed Design Description

#### 7.2.1 Input Capacitor Selection

A 1  $\mu$ F to 10  $\mu$ F ceramic capacitor is recommended to connect between IN and GND pins to decouple input power supply glitch and noise. The amount of the capacitance may be increased without limit. This input capacitor must be located as close as possible to the device to assure input stability and less noise. For PCB layout, a wide copper trace is required for both IN and GND.

#### 7.2.2 Output Capacitor Selection

An output capacitor is required for the stability of the LDO. The recommended output capacitance is from 1 µF to



10  $\mu$ F, Equivalent Series Resistance (ESR) is from 5m $\Omega$  to 100m $\Omega$ , and temperature characteristics are X7R or X5R. Higher capacitance values help to improve load/line transient response. The output capacitance may be increased to keep low undershoot/overshoot. Place output capacitor as close as possible to OUT and GND pins.

#### 7.3 Power Dissipation

Circuit reliability demands that proper consideration is given to device power dissipation, location of the circuit on the printed circuit board (PCB), and correct sizing of the thermal plane. The PCB area around the regulator must be as free as possible of other heat-generating devices that cause added thermal stresses.

Power dissipation in the regulator depends on the input-to-output voltage difference and load conditions.

$$P_{D} = (V_{IN} - V_{OUT}) \times I_{OUT} + V_{IN} \times I_{GND}$$

 $V_{IN} \times V_{OUT}$  represents the static power consumption of the LDO, the value is relatively small and can be ignored. An important note is that power dissipation can be minimized, and thus greater efficiency achieved, by proper selection of the system voltage rails. Proper selection allows the minimum input-to-output voltage differential to be obtained. The low dropout of the device allows for maximum efficiency across a wide range of output voltages.

The main heat conduction path for the device is through the thermal pad on the package. As such, the thermal pad must be soldered to a copper pad area under the device. This pad area contains an array of plated vias that conduct heat to any inner plane areas or to a bottom-side copper plane.

The maximum power dissipation determines the maximum allowable junction temperature  $(T_J)$  for the device. Power dissipation and junction temperature are most often related by the junction-to-ambient thermal resistance  $(\theta_{JA})$  of the combined PCB, device package, and the temperature of the ambient air  $(T_A)$ . The maximum power dissipation can be calculated as below:

$$T_{J} = T_{A} + \theta_{JA} \times P_{D} \tag{2}$$




Figure 8. Line Transient Response (Cout = 1uF)




Figure 9. Line Transient Response (C<sub>OUT</sub> = 10uF)




Figure 10. Load Transient Response (C<sub>OUT</sub> = 1uF)




Figure 11. Load Transient Response (C<sub>OUT</sub> = 10uF)




Figure 12. Start  $Up(C_{OUT} = 1uF)$ 




Figure 13. Start Up ( $C_{OUT} = 10uF$ )



## 8 Layout Guidelines and Example


By placing input and output capacitors on the same side of the PCB as the LDO, and placing them as close as is practical to the package can achieve the best performance. The ground connections for input and output capacitors must be back to the GD30LD2401 ground pin using as wide and as short of a copper trace as is practical.

Connections using long trace lengths, narrow trace widths, and/or connections through via must be avoided. These add parasitic inductances and resistance that results in worse performance especially during transient conditions.




# **DFN1x1-4 Package Outline**






